



Share of top-10% journals




Subjects with top rank

Classification)




Journal ranking by CiteScore across 330 subjects per Scopus Metrics database; source: Scopus data (2016)

Use Boolean operators to combine multiple terms:

布尔语言搜索

- Boolean operators currently supported include AND, OR, NOT, and the hyphen (or minus symbol)
- Boolean operators must be entered in all uppercase
- The hyphen (or minus symbol) is interpreted as the NOT operator

For example: black -hole will return results containing 'black', but exclude any instances where 'hole' appears with it.

- Boolean precedence is as follows:
 1. NOT
 2. AND
 3. OR

- Parentheses can be used when nesting clauses so the grouping is clear

For example: For a OR b AND c, enter a OR (b AND c)

- Quotation marks can be used to specify terms which must appear next to each other

For example: ("heart attack" OR "myocardial infarction") AND diabetes AND NOT cancer

Authorship: Do's and don'ts

General principles for who is listed first:

First Author:

- Conducts and/or supervises the data analysis and the proper presentation and interpretation of the results
- Puts paper together and submits the paper to journal

Co-Author(s):

- Makes intellectual contributions to the data analysis and contributes to data interpretation
- Reviews each paper draft
- Must be able to present the results, defend the implications and discuss study limitations

Abuses to be avoided:

Ghost Authors:

- Leaving out authors who should be included

Scientific Writers and 'Gift Authors':

- Including authors when they did not contribute significantly



The most serious issues to avoid

1. Introduction

Pyrroles [25, 1] pyrroles are an important class of nitrogen-containing five-membered cyclic compounds. They constitute the core unit of many natural products, synthetic [37] and, as serving as building blocks for porphyrin synthesis [42]. Members of this family have wide applications in medicinal chemistry, being used as antimicrobials, antitumor agents, and analgesics [43]. Pyrroles are also used in the synthesis of heterocyclic compounds [44]. These compounds can be prepared from the [45] classical Hantzsch procedure [6], 1,3-dipolar cycloaddition reactions [7],aza-Wittig reactions [8], annulations reactions [9], and other multistep procedures [10]. In addition, three new derivative synthesis routes have been developed [11]. Heterogeneous-supported catalysts remain one of the most significant and simple methods [14] to consist of cyclocondensation of primary amines with α,β -unsaturated compounds to produce *N*-substituted pyrroles. Several catalysts have been used for this reaction, such as SnCl_4 [11], $\text{Pb}(\text{Ts})_4$ [12], $\text{Fe}(\text{SO}_4)_3$ [13], $\text{Sc}(\text{OTf})_3$ [14], $\text{Bi}(\text{NO}_3)_3$ [15], $\text{SnCl}_2 \cdot 2\text{H}_2\text{O}$ [16], $\text{Ti}(\text{OPiv})_4$ [17], RuCl_3 [18], $\text{In}(\text{OTf})_3$ [19], ZnCl_2 [20], $\text{ZnCl}_2 \cdot 2\text{H}_2\text{O}$ [21], $\text{ZnCl}_2 \cdot 4\text{H}_2\text{O}$ [22], $\text{ZnCl}_2 \cdot 6\text{H}_2\text{O}$ [23], layered zirconium phosphate and phosphate [24], [53] montmorillonite KSF-clay and I_2 [26]. Interestingly, the above cyclocondensation process could proceed in ionic liquid [27] or ultrasound and microwave irradiation [28]. However, despite the potential utility of these catalysts, many of

these methodologies for the synthesis of pyrroles [11] are associated with several shortcomings such as low yields, prolonged reaction time, harsh reaction conditions, the requirement of excess of catalyst, the use of toxic and environmental hazard reagents, and tedious work-up [17] due to the generation of large amounts of toxic metal-containing waste. The main disadvantage of almost all existing methods is the difficulty of separation of the reaction mixture, procedure and their recovery and reuse is often impossible, which limit their use under the aspect of environmentally benign process [30].

Heterogeneous-supported catalysts have been gained much attention in recent years, as they [2] possess a number of advantages in preparative procedures [29,30]. Stabilization of catalysts on solid support improves the reaction activity, stability, and reproducibility of the catalysts, and the handling and reusability of catalysts which are all factors are important in industry [31]. Therefore, use of supported and reusable catalysts in organic transformations has economical and environmental advantages [32]. Recently, some heterogeneous-supported Lewis acid catalysts have been prepared by immobilization of the catalysts on [22] mer via coordination or covalent bonds [32]. Such polymeric [22] mer are usually as active and selective as their homogeneous counterparts. In addition, the polymeric nature, characteristics of being easily separable from the reaction mixture, recyclability, easier handling, non-toxicity, enhanced stability, and improved selectivity in various organic reactions. Polystyrene is one of the most widely studied heterogeneous and polymeric supports due to its environmental stability and hydrophobic nature

Can you plagiarise your own work? Text re-cycling/self-plagiarism

A grey area, but best to err on the side of caution: always cite/quote even your own previous work

For example

You publish a paper and in a later paper, copy your Introduction word-for word and perhaps a figure or two without citing the first paper

Editors may conclude that you intentionally exaggerated your output



- Help the editors reach a **quicker decision**.
- Tip the balance **for peer review**.




